

Educator Primer:

Module 2: Have Your say

The three videos of this module culminate in an invitation for students to complete the Phase 3 survey! These surveys are online and will require computer access. If your class needs paper copies to participate, please contact Stina Hanson at stina.hanson@vancouver.ca to coordinate the delivery and pick up of hard copies!

There are two different surveys available: The first is for our younger grades (likely Grades 3 - 7) it is shorter and uses some image choice questions to ask about future housing types, while the second is our full Phase 3 survey available via the TalkVancouver platform. The links to both surveys will be available via the Young Planners webpage for the duration of Phase 3 Public Engagement (until the end of November 2021).



Module 1 and all the videos of Module 2 will remain live on the website after both surveys have closed, likely until the end of the year. There will be another update to the education portal in the Spring of 2022 when the Draft Plan is released and new ways for your students to get involved! Staff will still be able to meet with classes even after the surveys have closed.

Phone a Friend!

City staff are available to meet with your classes if their are questions about the survey or any other aspects of the Education Portal program. Virtual sessions, in-person outdoor meetings, whatever options that fit with current public health orders are possible and can be supported.

The “That’s a Wrap” video walks through the survey and the types of questions that will be asked. It reminds students that responses are anonymous and that they can skip any question they don’t know the answer to, or just don’t want to respond to!

Ideally our high-school students will take the main Phase 3 survey on TalkVancouver, however the choice about how they provide their input is up to you (and them!). All responses will be part of the official engagement record and be used to shape the Draft Vancouver Plan that will be released next spring.
